ABB e-charging challenge: GENERAL RULES

Working in team, in maximum 4 PPT slides, you will have to present an innovative idea/project in the field of e-charging infrastructure for electrical mobility. You will have to focus on solutions that are easy to use for end-users, but at the same time maximizing sustainability (reduced impact on the electrical system, possibility to integrate different functions like energy storage, etc.).

Your proposal shall be short and clear:

- Cover slide: Title of the Project and the full names of the team members.
- First slide: Overview of the Project and its goals.
- <u>Second slide</u>: Focus on the technology and feasibility of the Project.
- <u>Third slide</u>: The potential role of ABB in terms of new products and innovation has to be shown.

The Participants' contribution has to be presented to the ABB jury by re-cording the explanation of the Project (max. three minutes) in the same file, using the PowerPoint "Record Slide Show" tool. The Slides shall be drafted in English. The recording of the explanation shall also be done in English.

Projects must be sent by email, by March 1st 2020 at 12 pm CET, to the following email address: it-futureofwork@abb.com.

The participants have to attach the PowerPoint file to their message or, alternatively, indicate in the message the link to the WeTransfer platform were the file can be downloaded.

How to participate:

- 1) Create a team of minimum 4 maximum 5 members, gender mixed. All must be regularly enrolled in University studies and every member of the team has to fill the enrollment form
- 2) The team leader has to send the project by e-mail and indicate "ABB e-charging challenge team name" as the object of the email
- 3) If you decide to participate in this challenge, ti means that you have read and accepted our Terms and Conditions indicated in the enrollment form

Deadline for applications: March 1st, 2019

The ABB jury will evaluate the projects after the deadline and the winners will be contacted via email within maximum 10 days from the deadline.
